



Summer Weather

Now that the weather is beginning to change, could you please ensure that your child has suncream and sunhats at nursery for their protection. Suncreams should be a minimum of factor 25. As a lot of your child's experiences and learning takes part outdoors it is essential that we protect them against the elements. Children who do not provide suncream will not be allowed outdoors in the warm sunny weather and will therefore miss out on a lot of fun and activities. Also please provide a cardigan or jumper incase it suddenly gets cold.

Reminder

Could parents please ensure that their child brings a bag with a set of spare clothing to nursery daily, or if you prefer leave a bag on their peg with appropriate clothing for the time of year in. Children who are toilet training will particularly need plenty of spare knickers and underpants.

Free childcare for 2yr olds

As from September we will be eligible to provide 15 hours free childcare per week during term time or 11 hours per week over 50 weeks of the year, if parents/families meet certain criteria. If the criteria laid down by government is met then your child would be eligible for free childcare the term after their 2nd birthday.
