


THE NURSERY NEWSLETTER

Open Day

Safety

If for any reason you need someone different to pick your child up from nursery please make sure we are introduced to them first. This is for your child's own safety as we will not let them be taken by just anyone. We do understand that emergencies do crop up and this is not always possible, in which case we would need to be informed and given a good description and a pass word which only the three parties will know.

Points to remember

Could parents please make sure that they do not open the door to other parents even if you know them, also can you make sure all doors and gates are closed firmly behind you.

A set of spare clothing should be provided for your child in case of accidents. These should ideally be kept in a small draw string bag on your child's coat peg.

Parents are also requested to keep to their correct session times, as the nursery is staffed around your requested hours.

Weather

Due to the unpredictable weather we experience in this country, could you please ensure that your child is dress according to the weather, as they do go outside daily.

How can you help?

Periodically the staff of your child's room may send home activity sheets. These will relate to activities carried out in nursery. It would be helpful if you could continue the learning at home and provide the girls with some feedback.

We are also always on the look out for house hold items for our junk modeling, e.g boxes, shiny paper, cardboard tubes, buttons, plastic tops, plastic cartons, ribbons, wool, costume jewelry etc.
