



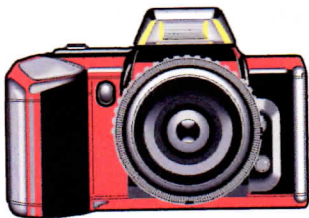

Photograph Day

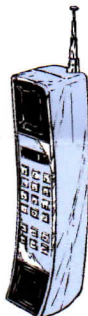
